ORDINANCE NO. 2009-55

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE SIZE OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF ROCKVILLE, MINNESOTA:

The Rockville City Council amends Section 5, Subdivision 1. Membership of the Zoning Ordinance to read:

There is hereby created a **5 Member** Planning Commission. initially consisting of the planning commissions for the City of Rockville, City of Pleasant Lake and the Town of Rockville. ~~DELETE UNDERLINED.~~

Initial appointments shall be made by the Council upon adoption of the first Zoning Ordinance for the combined City of Rockville. The term of the appointive members shall be five years, except that, of the seven members first appointed, one shall be appointed for a term of one year, one for two years, one for three years, one for four years, one for five years, one for six years, and one for seven years. The term of the appointive members shall be five years and no person may be appointed to more than two successive terms as a Planning Commission member. Any vacancy during the unexpired term of an appointed member shall be filled by the Council for the remainder of the term. ~~DELETE UNDERLINED.~~
