**PUBLIC HEARING – GRAND LAKE ROAD/FOWLER ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT-**

Mayor Hagen announced that a public hearing would now be held to consider the final assessment of the Grand Lake Road/Fowler Road Improvement Project.

Rena Weber presented a summary of the costs/distribution.

Harold & Gerald Molitor questioned their assessment as they felt they did not own property that received benefit. It was reported that they own property on the south side of Grand Lake Road and were assessed for 200' according to the assessment policy.

Member Willenbring questioned the deferment of assessments and how it was addressed.

**Member Volkmuth introduced the following resolution and moved for its adoption:**

**RESOLUTION NO. 2010-23**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING ASSESSMENT FOR THE GRAND LAKE/FOWLER ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS, pursuant to notice duly given as required by law, the City Council has met, heard and passed upon all objections to the proposed assessment for 2010 Grand Lake Road/Fowler Road Improvement Project, and has amended such proposed assessments as it deems just;**

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Rockville, Stearns County, Minnesota, as follows:**

- 1. Such proposed assessment, a copy of which is attached hereto and made part hereof is hereby accepted and shall constitute the special assessment against the lands named herein, and each tract of land there is hereby found to be benefited by the proposed improvements.**
- 2. The remaining assessments shall be payable in equal annual installments including principal and interest extending over a period of 10 years, with interest rate of four.seven five percent (4.75%) per annum, in the amount annually required to pay the principal over such a period at such a rate, the first of said installments to be payable with general taxes for the year 2011, collectible with such taxes during the year 2011. Interest shall accrue from and after December 10, 2010.**
- 3. The owner of the property so assessed may at any time prior to the certification of the assessment to the County Auditor, pay to the Administrator/Clerk, and thereafter at any time prior to November 15 of any year pay to the County Auditor or Administrator/Clerk, the whole of the principal amount of the assessment on such property provided that no such prepayment shall be accepted without payment of all installments due to and including December 31 of the year of the prepayment, and the original principal amount reduced only by the amounts of principal included in such installments computed on an annual amortization basis.**
- 4. The Administrator/Clerk shall forthwith transmit a certified duplicate copy of this assessment to the County Auditor to be extended on the tax list of the County.**

**The motion for the foregoing resolution was duly seconded by Member Becker with the following vote being taken:**
