

Ordinance No. 2003-07

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON CITY STREETS FOR MORE THAN 72 HOURS & REGULATING PARKING ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS DURING WINTER MONTHS

The Rockville City Council ordains:

SECTION 1. Section 71.06 of the City Code his hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

§ 71.06 OVERNIGHT PARKING

It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle, truck, semi tractor or semi trailer, trailer, camper trailer, construction trailer, house trailer, motorcycle, dumpster or any other structure on any street, avenue or highway within this municipality for more than 72 consecutive hours. After 72 consecutive hours such vehicles, trailers or structures may be towed away at the owner's expense.

§ 71.06A REGULATING PARKING ON CERTAIN CITY STREETS DURING WINTER MONTHS

With the exception of Birch Street South, no person, firm or corporation shall park a vehicle on any roadway within the City of Rockville between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any day from November 1 to April 1, inclusive, of each year. A special parking zone is hereby established for the street designated as Birch Street South. On Birch Street South there shall be no vehicles parked on the east side of said street between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any Tuesday, Thursday, or Saturday. Further providing that there shall be no vehicles parked on the west side of Birch Street South between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any Monday, Wednesday, Friday or Sunday. The restrictions regarding Birch Street South shall apply for the total period of January 1 through December 31 of each year.

§ 71.06B If any vehicle is parked, abandoned, or left standing in violation of the terms of this ordinance, the same may be moved by the city at the cost and expense of the owner thereof.

§ 71.06C If any vehicle is found upon a roadway in violation of any provisions of this ordinance regulating the stopping or parking of vehicles, and the identity of the driver cannot be determined, the owner or person in whose name such vehicle is registered shall be held prime facie responsible for such violation.

§ 71.06D Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished to the full extent of the law.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage.
