RESOLUTION APPROVING STATE OF MINNESOTA JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS WITH THE CITY OF ROCKVILLE ON BEHALF OF ITS CITY ATTORNEY AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Rockville on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Law Enforcement Agency desires to enter into Joint Powers Agreements with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to use systems and tools available over the State's criminal justice data communications network for which the City is eligible. The Joint Powers Agreements further provide the City with the ability to add, modify and delete connectivity, systems and tools over the five year life of the agreement and obligates the City to pay the costs for the network connection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Rockville, Minnesota as follows:

1. That the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements by and between the State of Minnesota acting through its Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the City of Rockville on behalf of its Prosecuting Attorney and Law Enforcement Agency, are hereby approved. Copies of the two Joint Powers Agreements are attached to this Resolution and made a part of it.

2. That the Sheriff, John Sanner, or his successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Law Enforcement Agency. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.

To assist the Authorized Representative with the administration of the agreement, Chief Deputy Bruce Bechtold is appointed as the Authorized Representative's designee.

3. That the County Attorney, Janelle Kendall, or her successor, is designated the Authorized Representative for the Prosecuting Attorney. The Authorized Representative is also authorized to sign any subsequent amendment or agreement that may be required by the State of Minnesota to maintain the City's connection to the systems and tools offered by the State.

To assist the Authorized Representative with the administration of the agreement, Chief Deputy County Attorney Matthew Quinn is appointed as the Authorized Representative's designee.

4. That Jeff Hagen, the Mayor for the City of Rockville, and Martin Bode, the City Clerk, are authorized to sign the State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreements.
