

Rockville Park and Recreation Board
Minutes of April 3, 2014 meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00

Present: Scott, Rick, Paul, Lori and Roger

1. March meeting minutes were approved with a motion by Paul and a second by Scott.
2. Bryan could not be here tonight. He did find a pitching machine he liked in our price range (around \$600.00). We will give \$200.00 and the rest should come from some sponsors (check with Duane for the sponsors before ordering). The hats will be \$9-10.00. On the morning of Summer Ball sign-up we had 30 kids register. The C.S. Record had notices in it that said registrations would be taken through April.
3. Nature Parks & Trails did not meet tonight, but do plan to start again in May. The wood still left in Eagle Park is spoken for and will be picked up as soon as it is dry enough.
4. There was a Rocori Trail meeting this morning. The contract with SEH was approved. Cold Spring may plant some trees along the trail.
5. Paul said some trees may need to be replaced in Lions Park. There is also a tree to be replaced in the rain garden at City Hall.
6. The Lions Club and some Girl Scouts will be building Bluebird houses. These will be placed in the prairie areas of Eagle Park or Lions Park.
7. There was some vandalism near the old Pleasant Lake City Hall from vehicles driving where they shouldn't. (These people were caught) There is also some gravel damage in the parking lot from plowing.
8. We did get a Thank You card from the Salvation Army Food Shelf in Cold Spring for the donation of 122 lbs. of food we gave from the collection at Santa Day.
9. The Easter Egg Hunt (April 19 at 10:00) has been advertised in the C. S. Record, and on Channel 10. The bunny suit is ordered. Lori has ordered items for the gift bags, and is getting pop donated, and will buy the chips, and put together the grand prize baskets. We will meet at 6:00 on Friday April 18 to stuff all the eggs and then put together the gift bags. Then meet around 8:30 on Saturday to finish setting up. Scott will check with Honers if they can bring live bunnies again.
10. Roger brought some articles on what adults like at parks, along with some equipment ideas we looked at. We might like to start with a couple of pieces and stay under \$2000. Then we will watch to see if they get used and maybe add a piece each year.
11. The City is not planning on hiring any summer help for mowing or other lawn/park care.
12. Motion to adjourn made by Scott with a second by Rick.
