Minutes of Feb. 6, 2014 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm

Present: Scott, Rick, Paul, Lori & Duane

1. Jan. meeting minutes were approved (with a spelling correction) with a motion by Paul and a second by Rick.
2. Ball Program: Changes to be made to the registration form are raising all fees by \$5.00 (except for T-ball and Pitch ball) and the hats from \$7 to \$10 (due to the increased costs to have them made). Motion to make these changes made by Rick with a second by Paul. Saturday, March 29 will be ball sign up from 10-11:00 at City hall. Our plan is to purchase a pitching machine at a cost of around \$600.00. We (the Park Board) will give \$200 towards this along with sponsor donations or possibly a grant. Motion by Scott with a second by Paul to have Bryan go ahead and purchase the pitching machine. Bryan was wondering if he should be prepping the fields for games, but since we do have a full staff again in the maint. dept. the city should be doing it. Do we or can we hire a part-time concession worker? We will wait to see what response we get from registration. Bryan can go ahead and get whatever equipment he needs.
3. Rock-Fest is not going to happen this year. It is just too expensive and getting harder and harder to find volunteers to run it.
4. Roger K. will finish up the electrical/lighting in the shelter at Lions Park. He also will give us an estimate on putting in the security light at the Comm. Park ball field.
5. Duane will have some wood workers make us a new wood pencil game for Santa Day. (The styrofoam one was in pretty bad shape.)
6. The skating rink is not getting used – is it being plowed?? With all the snow we have had, the rink has not been a priority for the city to plow.
7. We are planning a Winter Fun Fest day for Sat. Feb. 22 from 1-3:00. We need to let the city know that the rink and parking lot need to be plowed for that day. We will plan on hot cider, cookies, games, and prizes.

8. The Polar Plunge is planned for Feb. 15. Paul is helping to coordinate the parking area in Lions Park.
9. Our annual Easter Egg Hunt is planned for Sat. April 19th. Lori will get things ordered for the gift bags we hand out.
10. The Rocori Trail did get \$920,000 in funding – and applying for another \$600,000 to finish Phase II. Phase I is totally completed.
11. We are still working on getting more members on our Park Board, and would prefer them to be from the core city area or from the Grand Lake area, (since the 4 members on it now are all from the Pleasant Lake area).
12. Scott is checking into the costs of possibly putting in some exercise equipment along the path surrounding Lions Park.
13. Motion to adjourn by Rick, with a second by Paul.
