

# Rockville Park & Recreation Board

## Minutes of June 5, 2014 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:03pm

Present: Scott, Lori, Roger, & Duane

1. The May meeting minutes were not approved because Lori forgot them at home, so we decided to just wait until the next meeting to approve them.
2. **Nature Parks & Trails:** A new basswood tree has been planted in Eagle Park near the stone table. (Thanks Paul) Andy has been keeping the trail free of weeds by spraying, and Tim has been mowing. Thanks for their efforts! Anyone is welcome to go pull weeds or thistles anytime!! The canoe landing sign is hung up. Jokingly Eagle Park has been renamed Eagle Lake! HAHA. Any ideas of what to replace some of the dead shrubs with? Once the water level is down Tim & Duane will put larger brackets on the wooden bridge so it will slide up and down better, without binding. Driveway into Eagle Park is rutted. Roger will see if the City can do anything with it. The dock also needs some repairing. The Rocori Trail comm. will be filling in the smaller cracks and the larger ones will be milled out and repaired. John Peck has replaced Rick T. as the Rockville representative (along with Duane) on this committee. Thanks John!
3. **Summer Ball Program:** The games have all started and the concession stand is open. Working on getting the security light up by left field. Scoreboard was fixed, but probably will never find parts for it again. The city was asking if we could use the Lions Park field for T-ball instead of the school since we have to pay for a port-a-potty to be there. We discussed this and decided it was best left at the school for a better Rockville location, and it is only 2 months of rental.
4. Discussed items to put in the next newsletter. Suggestions were the bluebird houses that were built and put up, Summer Ball program, summary of the Easter Egg Hunt, future VB net in hockey rink.
5. We picked out 2 pieces of exercise equipment to put along the walking path in Lions Park. Scott made a motion to do a *request for council action* to purchase this equipment. This money would come out of the Park Dedication fees. This motion was seconded by Lori and passed.
6. The Lions Club is still trying to come up with a way to save that cement table at Lions Park, but if they can't it will have to be removed for safety reasons.
7. We really need to find more Park Board members. We are now down to 3 members.
8. A VB net was ordered.
9. Next year we will check into redoing the tar with an overlay for a better basketball court at Lions Park. Other ideas are doing something with the warming house or a picnic shelter at Comm. Park.
10. Motion by Scott with a second by Lori to adjourn.
