

Rockville Park & Recreation Board
Minutes of May 1st Meeting

Meeting called to order at 6:50

Present: Scott, Paul, Lori, Roger, Duane

1. April meeting minutes were approved with a motion by Scott and a second by Paul.
2. Rick Tallman has submitted his resignation from the Park Board. He will be missed, but will help out with some of our events when possible.
3. Bryan D. did make it tonight. The pitching machine has been ordered. New hats have been ordered, but not the jerseys/T shirts yet. We are still needing a few more players to fill some teams. We also still need coaches. There are 3 applications for umpires, and we do have a concession stand worker. The city employees will drag and mow the fields and Bryan will fine tune and chalk.
4. The ball field still needs the security light added to the left field pole. We also need to fix the scoreboard and would like to add an outside faucet. We also have talked in the past about adding another picnic table. Roger will check into some of these items.
5. There was a Nature Parks and Trails meeting before this one tonight. Ten people were present. Kids coming out on the 29th was cancelled due to weather. May 7 there are Cathedral students scheduled to tour the parks and Pecks farm. Roger will work on fixing the dock, and then it can be put in when the water goes down a little. Linda has been working on the gardens. Some shrubs may have been lost this year. The canoe sign will be put out soon. The remaining wood will be removed as soon as it is drier. There is \$300 in insurance money to replace a tree in Eagles Park, which will probably be placed near the table for shade. The Lions Club and a G.S. Troop are building 11 bluebird houses. They will be placed in Lions Park on Sat at 10:00 along with an Ornithologist to do some teaching about bluebirds.
6. Wes E. was present to talk to the park board about an event he would like to hold in Lions Park. He wants to put on a Plymouth Road Runner car show, with about 25-50 cars. He is looking at Sat. Sept. 6th from approx. 8-1:00. There was a motion by Paul, with a second by Lori, to go ahead with this proposal as long as the insurance needs are met, and a deposit for any damage is given.
7. Roger will get a VB net ordered for the hockey rink VB court. Duane said he has some poles on wheels with cement.
8. Next month we will talk again about what exercise equipment we want to order to install along the walking path in Lions Park.
9. The broken cement pieces from the cement table benches have been removed. The Lions Club is still planning on fixing and installing this table.
10. Roger has been doing some checking and inspecting of the parks and the equipment in them.

11. We talked about the possibility of doing a small BMX bike trail with some hills or moguls, maybe down on the west end of the park (outside of the walking path).
12. A motion to adjourn was made by Lori with a second by Scott.
