

3. 24/7 SERVICE

Our contract includes adult criminal and juvenile investigative legal advice for all members of Stearns County law enforcement agencies; 8 attorneys carry cell phones 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for law enforcement legal advice as needed.

4. NO COST LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING and VICTIM ASSISTANCE

In 2013 we provided **48.5 hours of law enforcement training opportunities** and legal updates at no cost to all members of Stearns County law enforcement agencies. Additionally, we assist victims of crime as allowed by law through personal help, referrals, and restitution collection.

Dear Mayor Hagen and Council Members Susan Palmer, Don Simon, Randy Volkmuth and Duane Willenbring:

Thank you for participating in the Stearns County Attorney's Office Adult Diversion Program. In 2013 we offered the Adult Diversion Program to 138 adults who met the initial eligibility criteria. The total number of adults admitted to the diversion program was 101 (fifty-six females and forty-five males). Currently, eighty (80) adults have successfully completed diversion, eleven (11) are pending disposition and ten (10) were terminated and sent to court.

All of the adults entered diversion for misdemeanor offenses. The most common offense diverted was shoplifting with 89% of the cases. Theft was second, followed by criminal damage and possession of stolen property.

Regarding your specific jurisdiction (**City of Rockville**), there were no adults or juveniles who qualified for diversion. Diversion participants completed a total of 1,610.5 hours of community service in 2013. There were fourteen (14) hours of community service done in Rockville by diversion participants from other jurisdictions. They picked up garbage and helped relatives.
