

Rockville Park and Recreation Board Minutes of Nov. 5, 2015 Meeting

Meeting called to order at 7:00

Present: Scott, Paul, Lori

1. August meeting minutes were approved with a motion by Paul and a second by Scott.
2. Scott will double check that the city will stop the garbage pick-up in Lions Park and also get the portable toilets picked up.
3. The Lions Club did put cement slabs under the benches in Lions Park. They look very nice and will keep the weeds from growing up under them. Thank You!!
4. Paul is on the committee for the veterans' memorial. He is working on a grant. The Lions Club is spear heading this project. It may be 3 granite monuments displayed at the Fire Hall, honoring Military, Police and Fire.
5. The last meeting of the Nature Parks and Trails that Lori & Paul attended was held in Lions Park. We toured the rain gardens and prairies. Neither of us were able to attend the Oct. 1st meeting. There have been many students removing buckthorn. 260 students were there 2 weeks ago. Thanks to all the adult volunteers that helped with this! It was a great teaching opportunity for those students.
6. The MN Conservation Corps did do a controlled burn in the prairies in Lions Park on Oct. 26. Paul headed this project. The rain gardens and prairies will not be cut down until spring.
7. People living on the area lakes need to be checking their docks for zebra mussels. The summer inspectors did not find any. But, we need to stay on top of this to prevent invasive aquatic species from becoming a problem.
8. Chris, the summer ball program coordinator, did not make the meeting tonight. We would like to get a final report and summary of the season from him. Looking at the financial papers it looks as though there was \$2490 in revenue from registrations and \$2108 from concessions, but we don't have the final expenses yet.
9. Santa Day will be Sunday, Dec. 6 from 1-3:00, at the Fire Hall. We will prepare for about 160 kids. For our next Park Board meeting we will meet right at the Fire Hall on Thurs. Dec. 3, have a short meeting, and then start setting up for Santa Day. Scott will confirm with the Fire Hall, and Bruce C. for photos and Brian for Santa. Lori will get prizes ordered and check into having some signs made to put up around the Pleasant Lake area. Scott will get the notice on the city marquee, the Cold Spring Record and get a flyer sent home to the John Clark families.
10. Motion by Paul to adjourn, with a second by Lori.
