

ROCKVILLE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
June 2, 2020
Rockville City Hall

Item 1) Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Mayor Duane Willenbring.

Item 2) Roll Call

Roll call was taken and the following members were present: Duane Willenbring, Bill Becker, Brian Herberg, Jerry Tippelt, and Don Simon.

Staff members present: City Administrator, Martin Bode and Finance Director, Judy Neu.

Others present: LMC Attorney, Jim Thomson; City Attorney, Susan Dege; and Paul Hedlund.

Item 3) Additions/Approval of Agenda

Motion by Herberg, second by Becker, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

Item 4) Closed Meeting - Per State Statute 13D.05, subd. 3(b) Attorney-Client Privilege, to discuss active and pending litigation

Item 5) Reconvene

- a. Summarize Closed Session
Attorney Susan Dege stated that per State Statute 13D.05, subd. 3(b) Attorney-Client Privilege, the Council went into closed session to discuss active and pending litigation.
- b. Council Action - None

Item 6) 210th Street

Member Herberg reported to the Council that Maine Prairie Township is requesting that the City of Rockville pay 100% of the cost of replacing the east culvert that is technically located in the City of Rockville. Also the Township would like the City to seek quotes and approve of a contractor to do the dirt work that is/may be needed on the north side of 210th Street.

The Council noted that the current maintenance agreement states the City and Township will cost share the cost of reconstruction of 210th Street on a 50-50 basis.

Motion by Becker, second by Willenbring, to approve of Maine Prairie Township's (MPT) request to repair/replace all seven (7) of the culverts and related dirt work along 210th Street between County Road 8 and Wakefield Township line on the same basis as the previously approved cooperative bidding agreement between the City of Rockville and MPT. Roll call vote. Voting yes; Willenbring, Tippelt and Becker. Voting no; Simon. Abstaining; Herberg. Motion carried on a 3-1-1 vote.

Item 7) Bar/Restaurant

- a. County/City – Right-of-Way/Sidewalk/Trail Use
Motion by Becker, second by Tippelt, to approve the county/city right-of-way/sidewalk/trail use to local businesses on a temporary basis during the COVID-19 restriction period. Motion passed unanimously.
- b. Hours operation Re: City Sidewalk/Trail or County Right-of-Way
Motion by Tippelt, second by Herberg, to the approve hours of operation for the use of city sidewalk/trail or county right-of-way to be the bar/restaurant's current normal business hours. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion by Tippelt, second by Simon, to adjourn the meeting at 10:21 a.m. Motion carried.
