

Questions and Answers about the Monument

Who is eligible? All **past, present and future** Law Enforcement Officers, Firefighters, First Responders and Military personnel. Any individual who has served under these titles, regardless of where they reside now, are encouraged to submit their name. Feel free to list, grandparents, fathers, mothers, sisters, brothers, aunts, uncles, sons, daughters, etc.

Can I submit my own name? Yes, absolutely you can submit your own name. You may be your own donor.

Families or groups may submit their names together in an envelope with a request to have names placed on the monument in a sequential order.

What do we want? The Monument needs you! We need individual names to be etched in the monument to give it meaning. Tell your family and friends we need them. To place a name on the monument for a lasting memory is \$125 per name.

Why are we doing this? To show our appreciation and honor to those who have and are currently contributing to our safety in our communities and our country. It is as much for those to be honored as it is for our families to have the honor of a loved one's name etched in the stone.

Monument Location? We looked into various areas of our community and because it does need to be on city property, we decided the most appropriate place would be in front of the Fire Hall in Rockville. It is a quiet place that will be handicapped assessable. It provides a location with ease of maintenance. It will have benches along the sides to sit on, to come and reflect on those who have served us so honorably.
