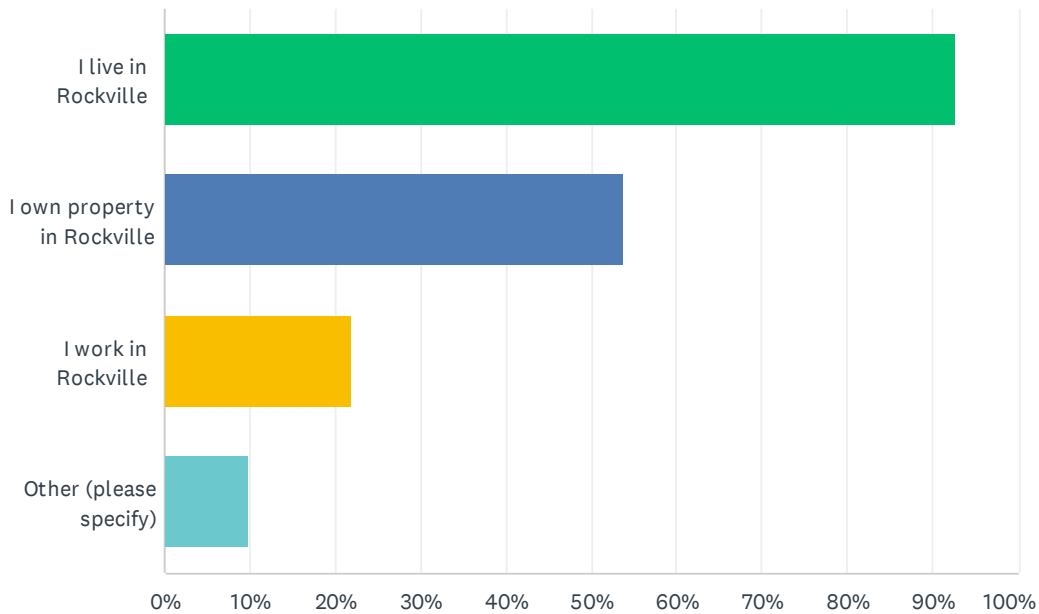


Q1 Tell us a little about yourself. Select all that apply.

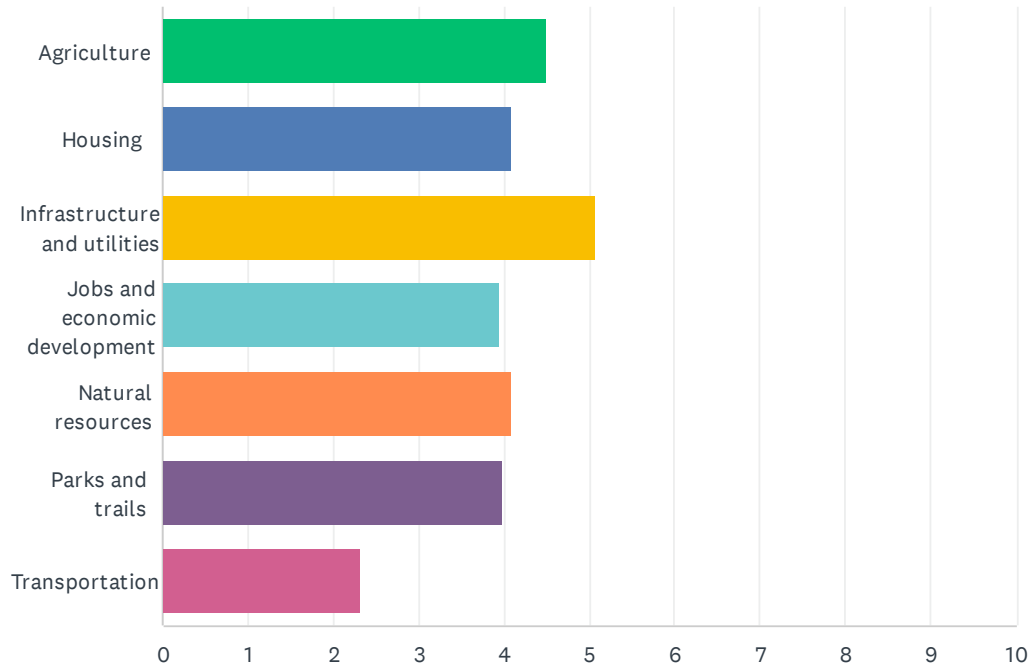

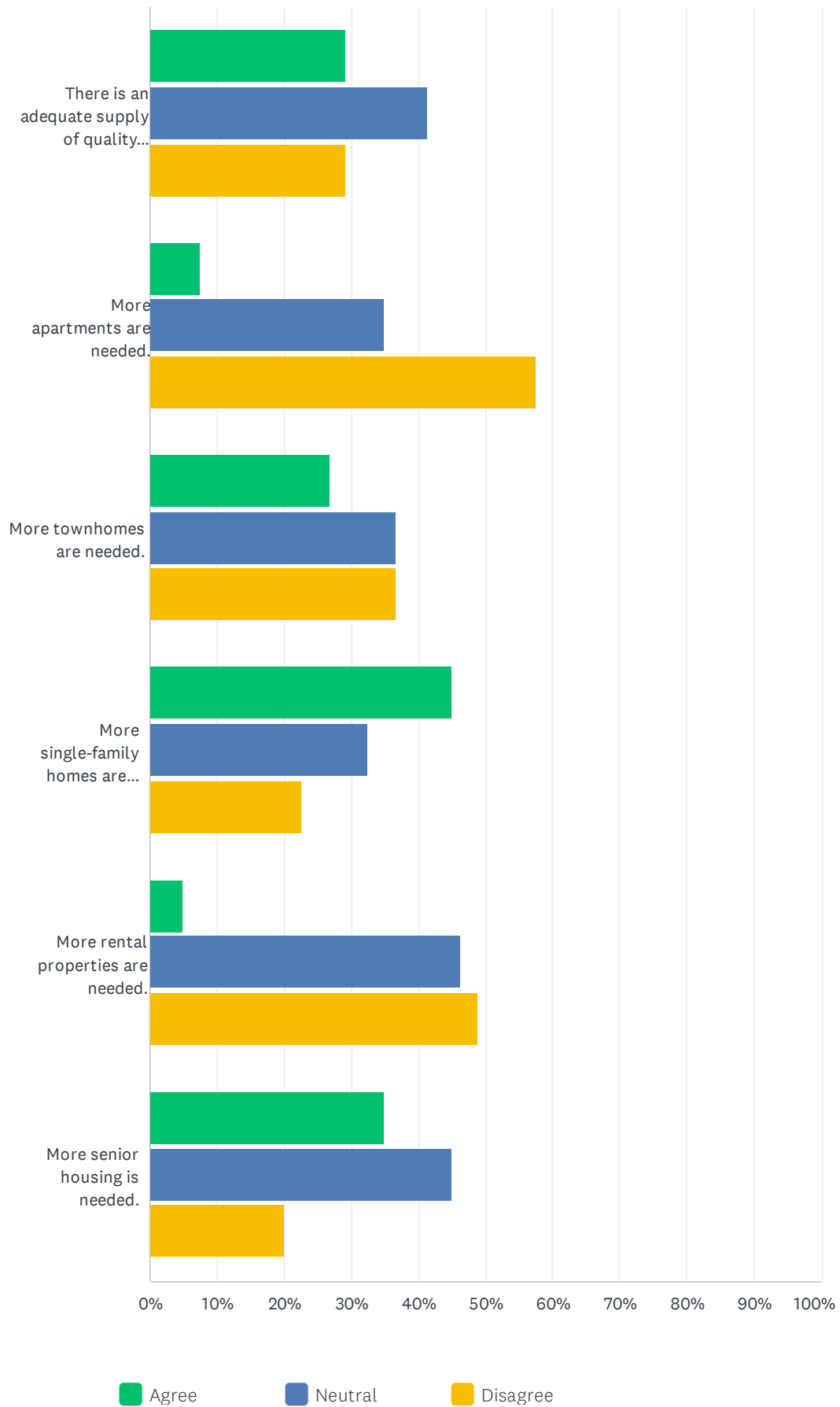

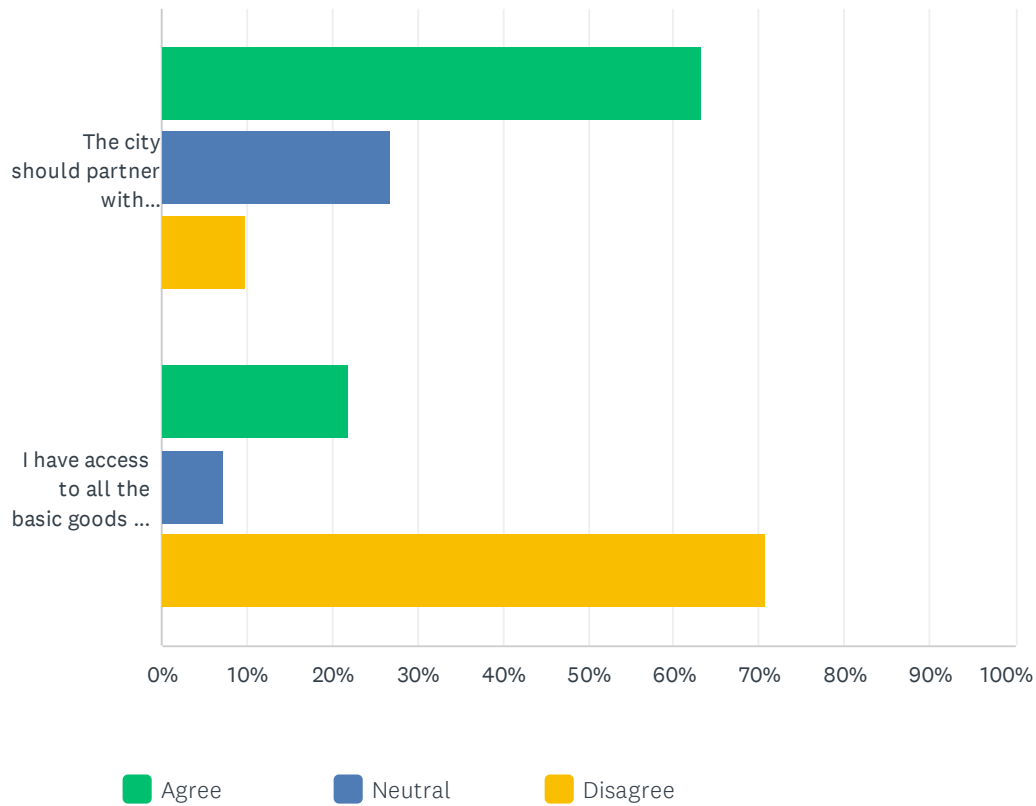

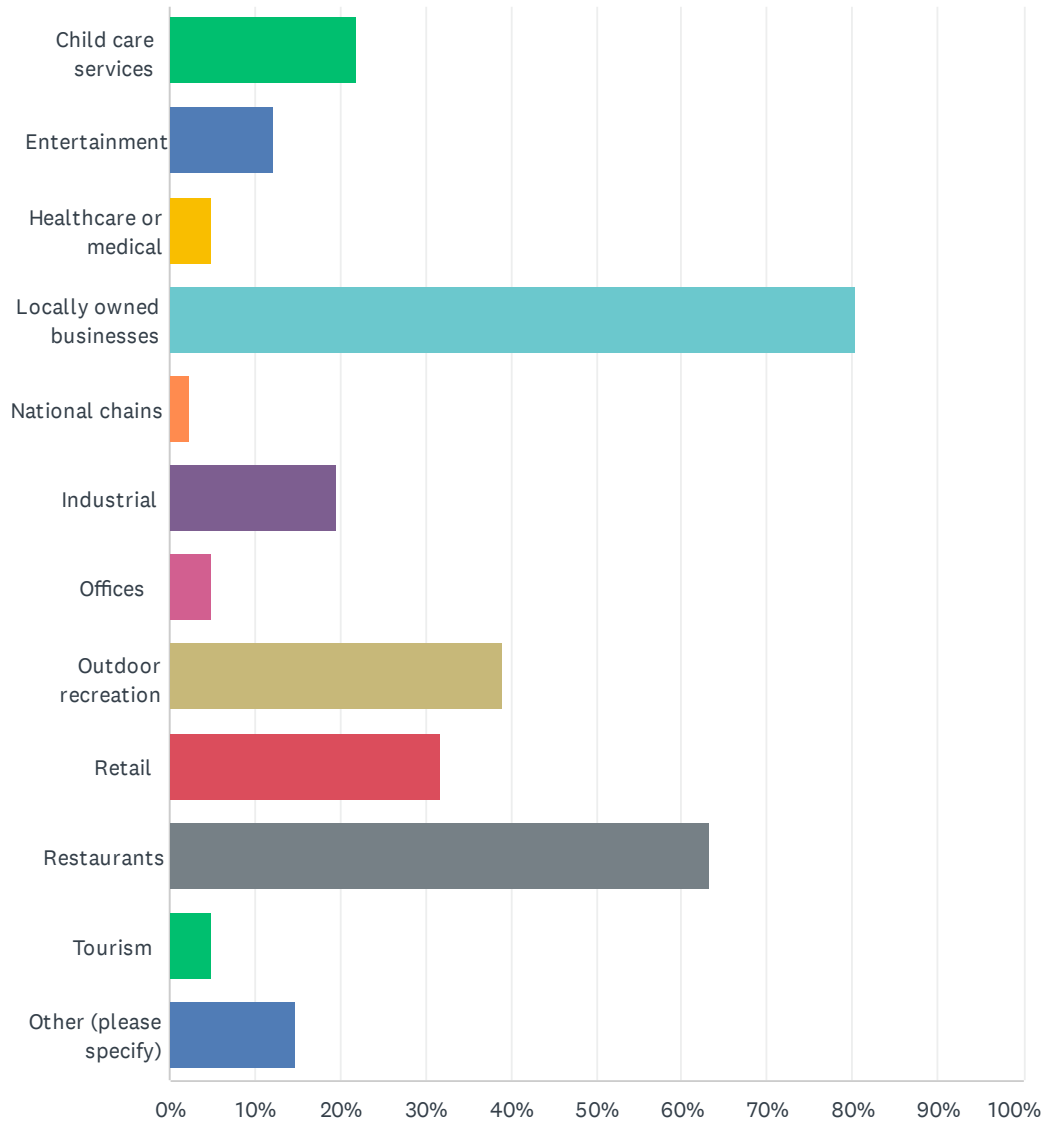

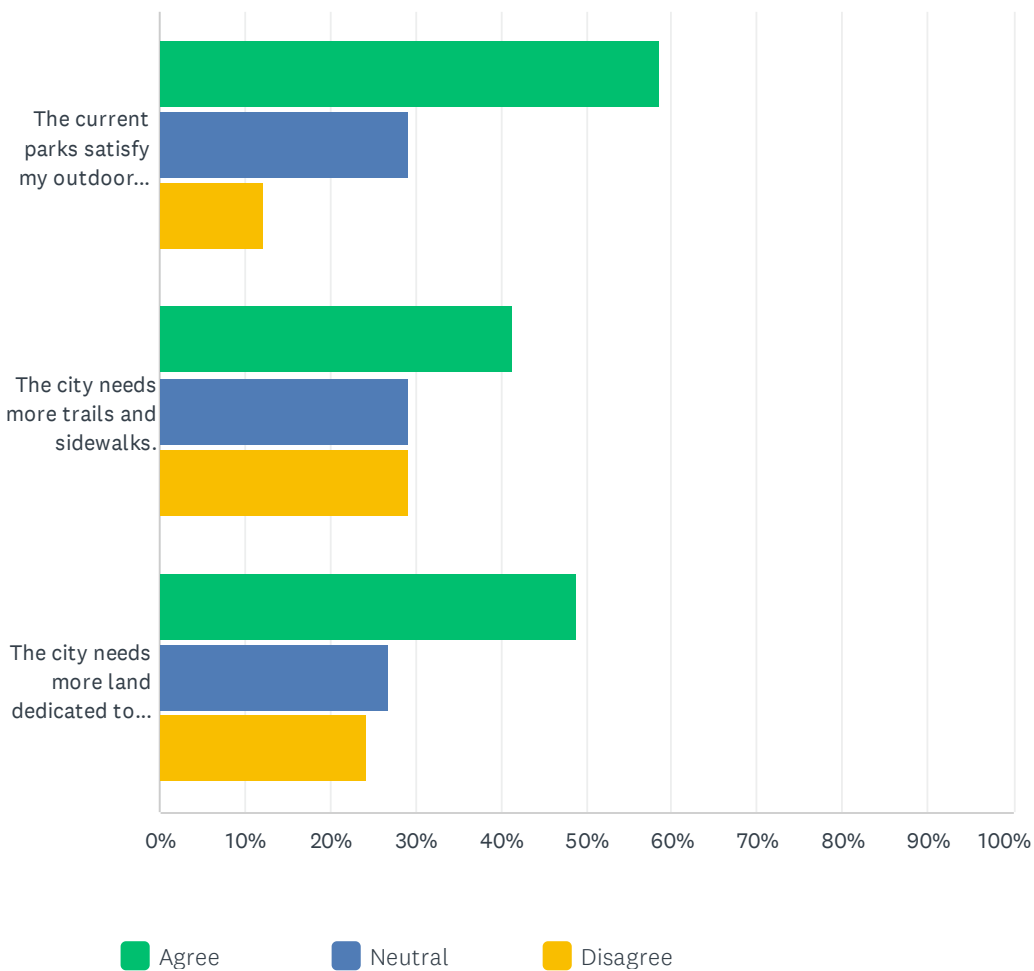

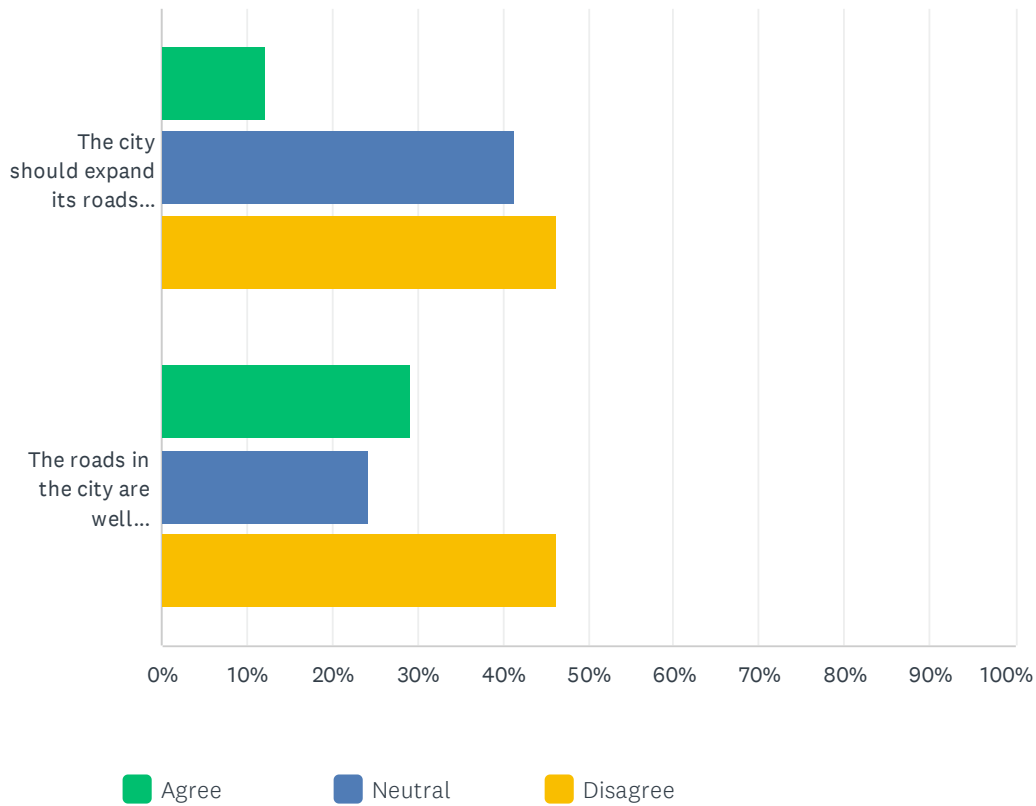

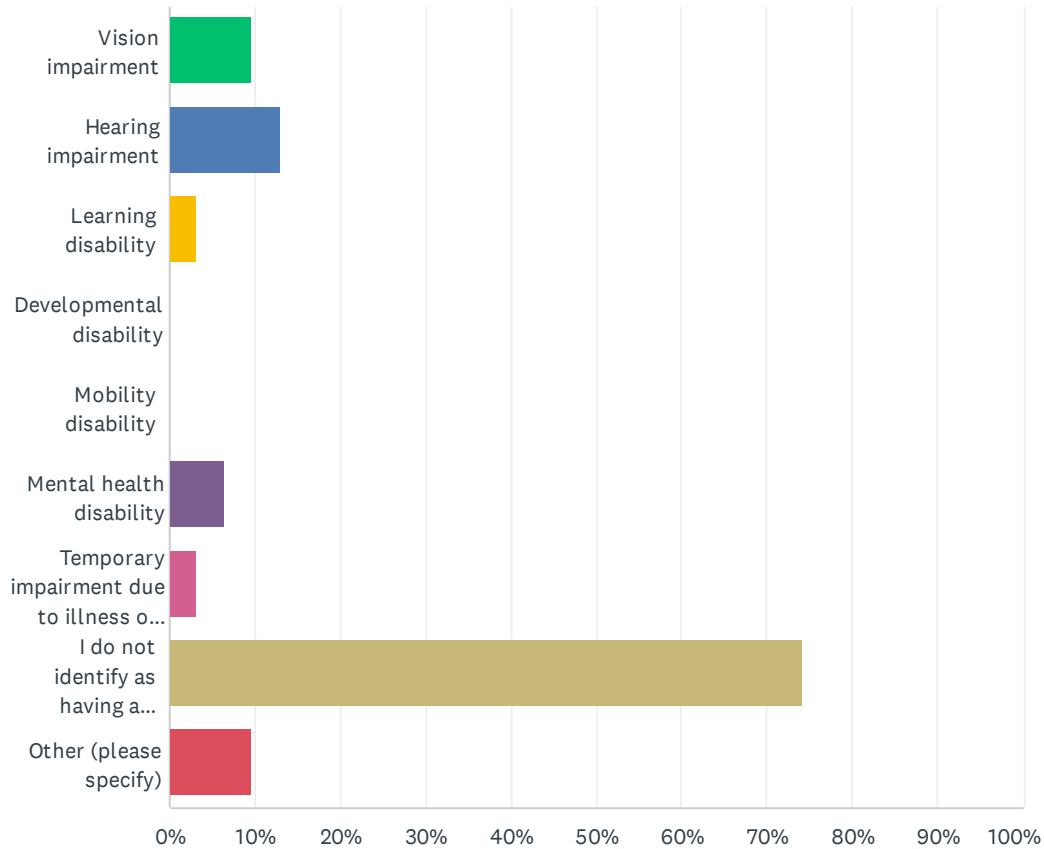
